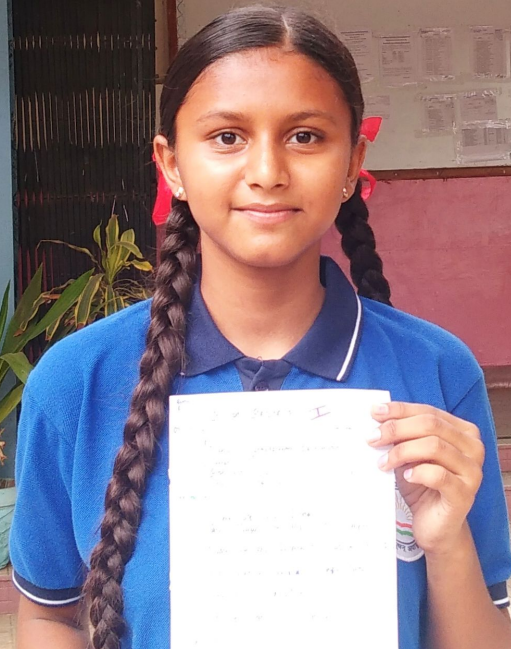

into all major Indian languages and has also received many awards.

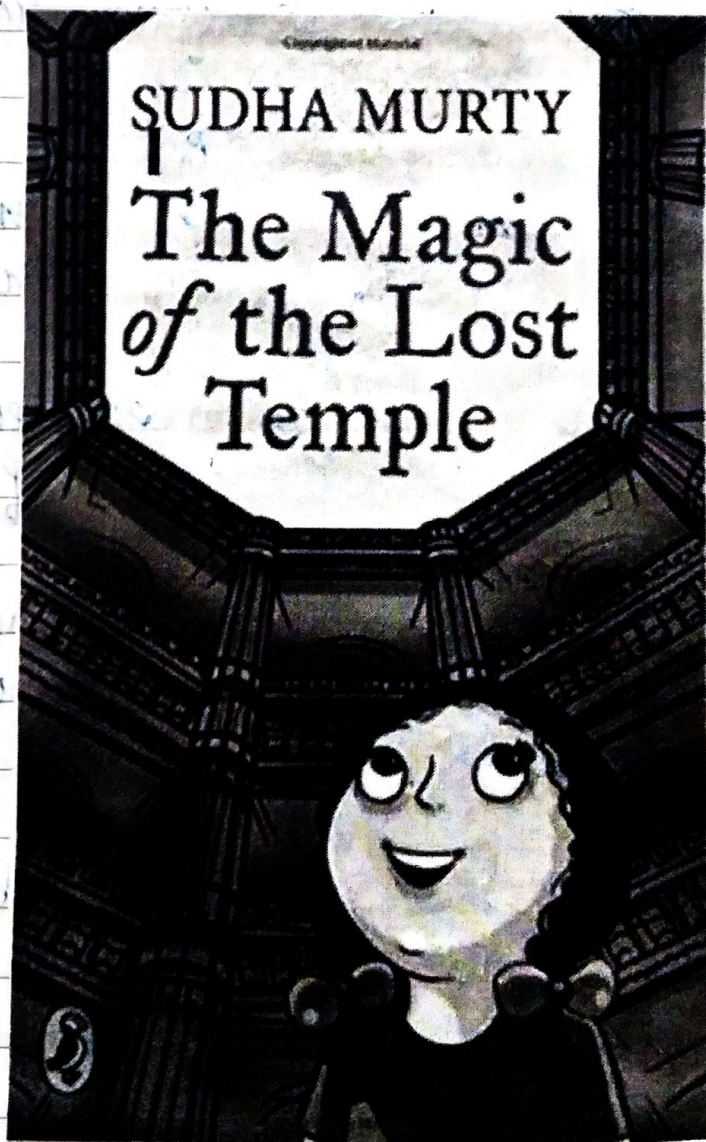
## \* ABOUT THE STORY
